APPENDIX – II
GUIDELINES FOR B.D. (Regular and Upgraders)
ENTRANCE EXAMINATION

The Entrance examination consists of three papers as outlined below:

1. BIBLE KNOWLEDGE (Time: 2 Hours)

The entrance examination in Bible knowledge will focus mainly on the applicant's knowledge of the content of the Bible.

2. ENGLISH (Time: 2 Hours)

The English examination aims at determining the level of English that the applicant already has and his/her potential for study in English at Gurukul Lutheran Theological College & Research Institute. The student is expected to have a basic knowledge of English Grammar and Composition. This will be done at two levels:

- Comprehending material written in English
- Expressing himself/herself in written form in English

Therefore the candidate will be examined in the following five areas: Comprehension, Composition, Precise-writing, Grammar, and Punctuation.

Questions will be based on “High School English Grammar and Composition” by Wren and Martin. Chand and Co.

3. GENERAL KNOWLEDGE (Time: 1 Hour)

General knowledge examination will focus on two areas:

- Questions of a contemporary nature in the following fields - Geography, History, Science, Fine Arts, Sports, Religions and Economics.
- Questions on current political, social, cultural, technological concerns in India.

The candidates are advised to read ‘Malayala Manorama 2019’ a book on general knowledge available in the local bookshops.
